The Noise Around Us -

Nowadays, we experience noise almost everywhere: in our homes, at work and in public places. During the day, we often suffer from the noise of traffic, airplanes and construction work. At night, we continue to be disturbed by traffic, car alarms and barking dogs. It seems that noise pollution is all around us and we can't avoid it.

- Many studies on children and adults have found that noise pollution is not only unpleasant but also causes stress. Stress can damage people's health and cause emotional and behavior problems. At night, noise is especially stressful as it can affect the quality of sleep. When people's sleep is disturbed night after night, they often become angry and aggressive.
- Noise pollution is also harmful to people's hearing. Adults may suffer from hearing problems because of loud noise at work. Young people, on the other hand, may damage their hearing by listening to music at a high volume for long periods of time. Hearing problems can change young people's behavior and affect their schoolwork.

Noise has a negative effect on schoolwork even when it doesn't cause hearing problems. Many studies have found that a noisy environment in schools can harm students' abilities to read, to solve problems, and to develop social relationships. One study, for example, was done in a school located near a train station in New York. The researchers found that students in classrooms that were opposite the train station had more reading difficulties compared to the students on the quiet side of the school. None of the students in either group had hearing problems. Their reading problems were the result of difficulty in concentrating and understanding what the teacher was saying. The study also found that students in noisy classrooms misbehaved more and were less helpful to other students.

People who are fighting noise pollution say that it reminds them of the fight against smoking. For a long time, people weren't aware of the dangers of smoking in public places, just as now people don't understand the dangers of noise pollution. Hopefully, the fight against noise pollution will succeed in the near future, otherwise more people will be harmed.
